Subject: Billings for Legal Services


Last Friday, Matt Campbell submitted an FOIA request to Daily & Woods for their time record sheets between January 13 and June 6, 2014. Daily & Woods has complied with the request and made the requested records available to Mr. Campbell.

Attached is a letter from Daily & Woods which provides an analysis of the timekeeper sheets compared to the billings to the city. The time billed between January and May 31 (the June services haven't been billed yet) totals 821.8 hours and is comprised of 879 entries. There were some minor differences found between the timekeeper sheets and the bills as described in Jerry's letter. In the final analysis, Daily & Woods billed the city for 4.5 fewer hours of service than documented on the timekeeper sheets (this was to the city's advantage).

The files with the actual timekeeper sheets are too large to send by e-mail. There's 292 pages. I've included a sample timekeeper sheet with this e-mail so that you can see what it looks like. If you would like any or all of the timekeeper sheets, please let me know and I'll have hard copies delivered to you.
